



Woolwich Township Police Department

Crime Log for October 2023

- 10/1 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Kings Highway and Mechanic Street in Swedesboro. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, transported back to headquarters, and processed before being released with a pending court date.
- 10/2 Officers were dispatched to downtown Swedesboro for the report of a dispute. Upon the officers' arrival, it was discovered that the accused had assaulted the victim prior to the officers' arrival. Due to the visible signs of injury, officers arrested the accused. They were transported back to headquarters where they were processed, charged, and released with a pending court date.
- 10/2 Officers were dispatched to Swedesboro for the report of an individual with a knife. Upon the officers' arrival, it was learned that the individual had pulled a knife on the victim. Officers were quickly able to secure the knife and arrest the individual. The individual was transported back to headquarters where they were processed, charged, and released with a pending court date.
- 10/2 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Center Square Road and Holly Drive in Woolwich Township. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, transported back to headquarters, and processed before being turned over to the Franklin Township Police Department.
- 10/3 Officers were contacted by the New Jersey State Police about an individual wanted out of Woolwich Township. NJSP advised they had located the suspect and had him in custody. Woolwich Township officers picked up the suspect from the NJSP and transported him to headquarters for processing. The subject was then lodged in the Salem County Jail on a Woolwich Township warrant.
- 10/7 Officers were dispatched to Paulsboro Road in Woolwich Township for the report of a dispute. Upon the officers' arrival, it was discovered that the accused had assaulted the victim prior to the officers' arrival. Due to the visible signs of injury, officers arrested the accused. They were transported back to headquarters where they were processed, charged, and released with a pending court date.

- 10/8 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Oldmans Creek Road and Meadowlark Drive. During the stop, officers determined the driver of the vehicle was under the influence. The driver was arrested, transported back to headquarters, and processed before being released to a guardian with a pending court date.
- 10/8 Officers were advised that there was a stolen motor vehicle in the area of Paulsboro Road and US RT 322. Officers arrived in the area and located the vehicle in the Wawa parking lot. The driver was arrested and the stolen vehicle was returned to the owner. The suspect was processed, charged, and turned over to the Deptford Township Police Department.
- 10/12 Officers were dispatched to the Woolwich Township Court for the report of a subject with a warrant. Officers learned the subject had an active warrant out of the Woolwich Township Joint Municipal Court. The subject was arrested and turned over to the Gloucester County Sheriff's Department.
- 10/15 Officers were dispatched to Shoprite for the report of shoplifting. Upon the officers' arrival, they spoke with the security guard and were shown a video of the suspect attempting to shoplift over \$650.00 worth of groceries. Officers arrested the suspect and transported them back to headquarters. Once at headquarters, they were processed, charged, and released with a pending court date.
- 10/15 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Oldmans Creek Road in Woolwich Township. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, transported back to headquarters, and processed before being released with a pending court date.
- 10/19 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Auburn Road and Oldmans Creek Road in Woolwich Township. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, transported back to headquarters, and processed before being released with a pending court date.
- 10/20 Officers were dispatched to Spirit Dodge for the report of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from the lot during the evening hours. The detective unit, along with the New Jersey State Police Auto Theft Unit, will be investigating the incident.
- 10/23 Officers were dispatched to Swedesboro for the report of a family dispute and criminal mischief complaint. Upon the officers' arrival, it was learned that one of the family members had smashed several items inside the home and attempted to lock the rest of the family outside while destroying the home. Officers quickly de-escalated the situation and arrested the subject. The subject was transported to headquarters, where they were processed, charged, and released with a court date.

- 10/27 Officers were dispatched to US RT 322 for the report of a motor vehicle crash. Upon their arrival, they learned that a vehicle and a pedestrian were involved. Patrol quickly provided medical care to the individual, who was later transported to the hospital. The driver of the vehicle remained on the scene. The accident is being investigated by the Motor Vehicle Crash Unit.
- 10/30 Officers were dispatched to Liquors for the report of shoplifting. Upon the officers' arrival, they spoke with the store employee and were shown a video of the suspect attempting to shoplift over \$50.00 worth of liquor. Officers arrested the suspect and transported them back to headquarters. Once at headquarters, they were processed, charged, and released with a pending court date.
- 10/31 Officers were dispatched to CVS on Center Square Road in Woolwich Township for the report of shoplifting. Several juveniles entered the store and took several items before fleeing the area. Patrol officers arrived and were able to gather video surveillance of the individuals. Patrol will be following up with the investigation.
