- 1/5, Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop of an erratic driver on Kings Highway. During the motor vehicle stop, it was determined the driver of the vehicle was intoxicated. The driver was arrested, processed, and issued for Driving under the Influence.
- 1/6, Officers were dispatched to Glen Echo Ave for the report of a theft. It was reported that the window of the caller's vehicle was smashed and their personal belongings were taken. The value of stolen items was over \$1,000. The matter is being investigated by the Detective Unit.
- 1/8, Officers responded to CVS, on center Square Road, for a shoplifting report. It was reported that less than \$50.00 in merchandise was taken from the store. Officers are following up with possible leads.
- 1/8, Officers were dispatched to High Hill Park for the report of a theft. It was reported that the window of the caller's vehicle was smashed and their personal belongings were taken. The value of the stolen items exceeded \$250. The matter is being investigated by the Detective Unit.
