Crime Log for July 2023

- 7/1 Detectives observed a hand-to-hand sale of narcotics in the area of Kings Highway and Auburn Road. Detectives were able to apprehend the seller after the suspected narcotics sale. The subject was arrested, charged, and released with a pending court date. Patrol Officers were able to locate and apprehended the buyer. The suspect was arrested, charged with possession of narcotics, and released with a pending court date.
- 7/2 Officers were dispatched to Locke Ave Park due to a fight. Upon their arrival, all individuals had fled the area. Later that day, the victim came forward, and the incident is being investigated by the detective unit.
- 7/4 Officers were dispatched to Locke Ave Park for a report of a trash can fire caused by fireworks. The trash cans were on fire due to hot fireworks being placed inside them. The fire caused damage to the pavilion. The incident is being investigated by the Gloucester County Fire Marshal and the detective unit.
- 7/6 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Monroeville Road in South Harrison Township. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, processed, and released with a pending court date.
- 7/6 Officers were dispatched to Shoprite for a theft report. Officers were able to locate the suspect and have the items paid for. No charges were filed at this time at the request of Shoprite.

- 7/14 Officers conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Auburn Road in Swedesboro. During the stop, officers located an active warrant for the driver. The driver was arrested, processed, and released with a pending court date.

- 7/20 Detectives located the stolen trucks from 7/19 with the help of a concerned citizen. The trucks were found in Philadelphia, but the trailers were not with them. The detective unit processed the trucks and will continue the investigation. The trailers and their contents are still missing at this time.
- 7/20 Officers were dispatched to Wawa for a report of a stolen cash register. The register was taken from the gas attendant's booth by 5 black males wearing facemasks and driving a stolen dark-colored Kia sedan. The register was later recovered in Delaware. This incident is being investigated by the detective unit.
